

Sixth Form Uniform

Our Sixth Form school uniform is as follows:

Item	Supplier	Additional Information
Lanyard and ID badge ¹	Finance Office	Free of Charge (a charge of £5.00 will be applied if a replacement is required)
Black Blazer (no badge required)	No preferred supplier	
Black school trousers	No preferred supplier	Trousers must not be skinny fit
Sixth Form school tie	Finance Office	£6.00. This can be purchased on results day or Wednesday 7 th September
White shirt	No preferred supplier	Buttoned to the neck and tucked in
Black shoes	No preferred supplier	Shoes should be plain, black, formal, and made of a polishable material. Boots, black trainers, suede, canvas, or casual shoes are not permitted. No trainers or plimsolls.
Socks (grey or black)	No preferred supplier	White socks are not acceptable

Sixth Form students are permitted to wear a wristwatch but should have no visible piercings or additional jewellery. There should be no head covering, other than for religious observation.

All Sixth Form students will be provided with a planner free of charge. If the planner is damaged or lost an additional planner must be purchased at the cost of £5.00
